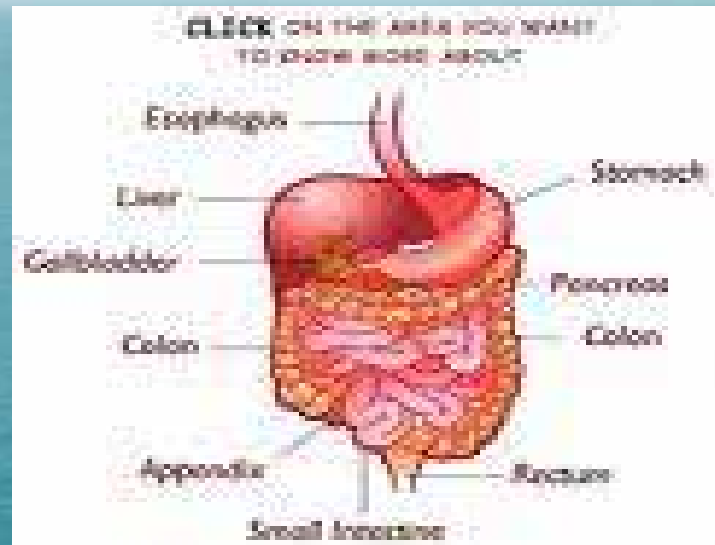

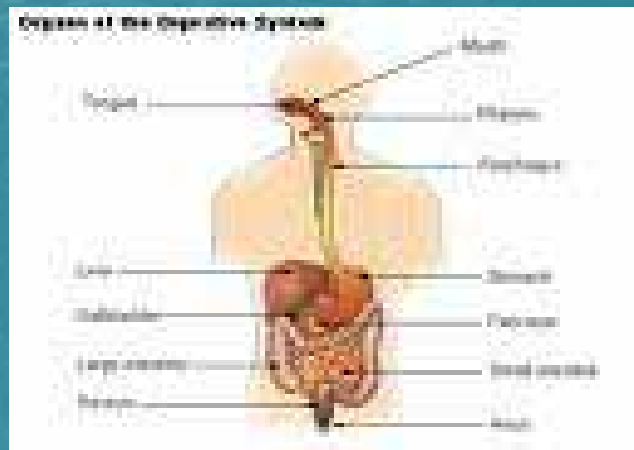

- Food stays in our stomach for 2-3 hours.

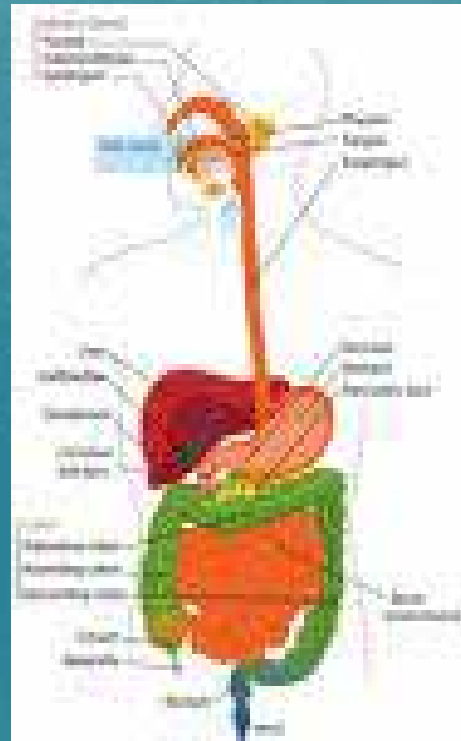


IMPORTANT FACTS

- Ulcerative Colitis

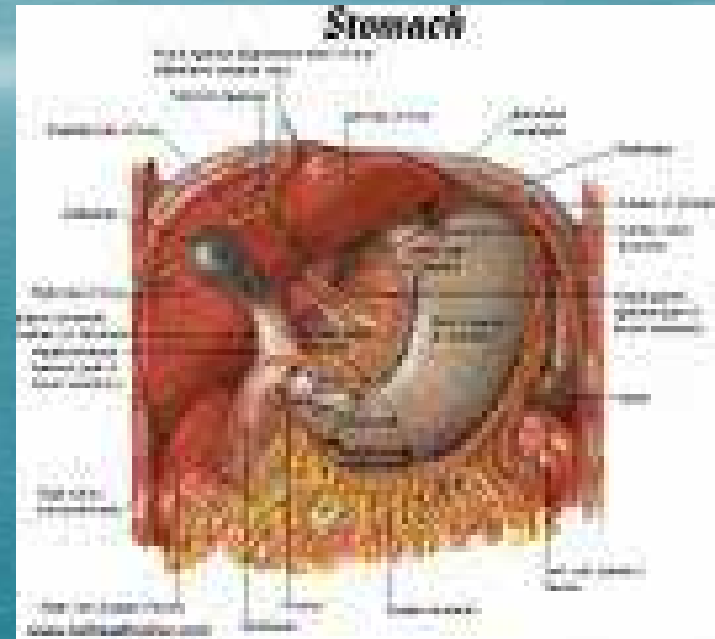


Inflammatory Bowel Disease
