Dear Parents and Guardians:

Registration for the 2018-2019 full-day kindergarten will begin on January 8, 2018. All registration will take place at our district Registration Center, located at the Evergreen Center, 400 Inman Ave, Room #7, Colonia, NJ (off Inman Ave by St. John Vianney). The process will be as follows:

1. You will be required to make an appointment by calling (732) 568-5635. No walk-ins accepted.
2. The student's parent or legal guardian must be present to register the child at the appointment.
3. The last name of the parent will determine the week of the appointment (schedule below).
4. Your child must be at least five years old by October 31, 2018 to register. No exceptions.
5. Prior to your appointment, please complete all registration forms on our website at: <https://sis.woodbridge.k12.nj.us/woodbridge/openReg?screen=welcomeScreen&action=form>
6. This form can be found on our website under the "Our District" drop down tab, then select "Student Registration" then select the "Kindergarten Registration" link.
7. In addition to the registration forms, parents must also submit copies of the following documents at their registration appointment:
 - o Child's birth certificate (copy).
 - o Proof of residency. Examples of documents include copies of a current deed, lease, or mortgage, or a tax bill.
 - o A copy of a current utility bill with the parent's name and address on it.
 - o Immunization records and medical records must be certified and translated if needed at time of registration.

The following immunizations are required:

1. DTaP – 4 doses with one given on or after the 4th birthday or any five doses.
2. Tdap – Children born on or after January 1, 1997 and enrolled in grade six or transferring into a New Jersey school from another state or country will be required to receive one dose of Tdap vaccine.
3. Polio – 3 doses with one given on or after the 4th birthday or any four doses. Intervals between the doses cannot be less than 1 month.
4. Measles - 2 doses of a measles containing vaccine with the first dose given on or after the 1st. birthday. Intervals between the first and second doses cannot be less than 1 month. Laboratory evidence of immunity is also acceptable.
5. Mumps-Rubella vaccines - 1 dose of each given on or after the 1st. birthday required. Laboratory evidence of immunity is also acceptable.
6. Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine– 1 dose given on or after the 1st. birthday. Children, who present documented laboratory evidence, a physician's statement, or parental statement of previous varicella disease, shall not be required to receive the varicella vaccine.
7. Haemophilus Influenza B (Hib)-mandated for preschool students only. Minimum of one dose needed after the 1st birthday.
8. Hepatitis B vaccine - 3 doses or laboratory evidence of immunity.

9. Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine – Mandated for preschool students only. Minimum of one dose needed after the 1st birthday.
10. Meningococcal conjugate vaccine – Children born on or after January 1, 1997 and enrolled in grade six or transferring into a New Jersey school from another state or country will be required to receive one dose on meningococcal conjugate vaccine.
11. Flu vaccine – Proof of an annual influenza vaccine for preschool students.
12. Mantoux Tuberculin Test may be required depending on country of birth.

Your child is required to have a physical examination upon entry into the school district. This exam must have been conducted no more than one year prior to entry.

If proper and complete documentation of immunization is not provided at registration, your child may not be able to begin school in September. If any records are not immediately available, your child should be registered and the records produced as soon as possible.

For your information the Woodbridge Board of Health holds an immunization clinic the second Wednesday of the month for students who do not have health care insurance. Additional Info:

1. Every effort will be made to keep students at their home schools. The numbers of kindergarten classrooms at each school will determine the maximum number of students who can attend their home school.
2. Kennedy Park School #24, located off Middlesex Ave in Iselin, will be the overflow school. Any kindergarten students who are not assigned to their home school will attend #24. They will return to their home school the following year and continue for grades 1-5.
3. School assignment will not be finalized until registration is completed in March 2018.
4. Factors considered in assigning which kindergarten students attend their home schools:
 - a. Capacity of kindergarten classrooms at the school
 - b. Number of kindergarten students who register
 - c. Siblings in the school
 - d. Walkers v. bussed students

- e. Late registration—students who register late will have less of a chance of attending their home school (depending on the school). Assignment to home school is NOT first come, first serve.
5. Before and after care will be offered at Kennedy Park.
6. Full registration **MAY NOT** be guaranteed if any paperwork is incomplete.
7. You will be contacted by your home school if any additional info is needed, such as medical, academic, or ELL.
8. Your child’s picture will be taken at registration. This picture will be part of his or her records for identification purposes only.
9. You will receive other paperwork at registration that you will be asked to complete and send in with your child on the first day of school (fingerprinting form, free and reduced lunch forms, etc.).

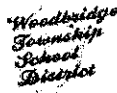
